

Child's Bass Guitar Specs:

Electric guitars/basses are usual marked in scale length.
34" (inches) is a standard full size bass.

Your child will need anything from 25" to 30". There are very few really short scale basses, some of which are quite expensive, Therefore a 30" is probably the best option.

If you buy separate the things you will need are:

- 1, Short Scale 4 string electric bass guitar
- 2, Small practice amplifier (about 15 watts)
- 3, Jack to jack lead for connecting bass to amplifier.
- 4, Soft case for the bass.
- 5, The following book: Bass 1 (fast track music instruction) by Blake Neely and Jeff Schroedl, pub by Hal Leonard (The Book edition with accompanying CD. NOT **the DVD version or the "Songbook"**) – (This is available from Musicroom.com amongst other places – cat no, HLE00697284)

Ibanez TMB30-BK 30" Short Scale Bass
Fender SQ Jaguar Special Bass
Squier Vintage Modified Jaguar Bass
Squire Bronco Bass Guitar

All the above basses are 30" scales length.
